Class Rules

- Classes grouped in box run concurrently. When cross-entering classes, pay only one cattle/office/judge fee.
- NRCHA rules apply. \$10 NRCHA fee applies to all approved classes regardless of cross-entry.
- Derby & Futurity classes pay 30% of purse to top 3 places of high go-round scores, 70% to final placement.
- All classes pay back according to NRCHA scale.
- All owners and riders must be a member of NRCHA for approved classes, and CMRCHA for all classes. You may join at the show.

Entry & Scratch Policy

Enter by August 8th for cattle and stall counts. Scratches prior to the draw will receive a full refund, scratches after the draw will receive only the \$10 NRCHA fee back. All scratches must be confirmed by the show secretary. Entries after the draw are considered late. Late entries are accepted and will be drawn last.

Important! All dogs MUST be on a leash at ALL TIMES! Regardless of how well behaved they are (subject to fines). All arena rules must be adhered to, rules can be found on CMRCHA website.
